## **Movie Maker**

Movie Maker allows you to combine video, audio and pictures into a single video file.



Movie Maker files play from locally stored files, because of this a shared/uploaded Movie Maker file(\*.wlmp) will not contain any of the original content (e.g. images and music).

To allow other people to view your 'Movie' you will need to export it as a mp4 or video file.

## Exporting a Movie Maker File

Use this tutorial to export your Movie Maker as a mp4 or video file.



2. Select 'Save Movie' and then 'Recommended for this project'.
