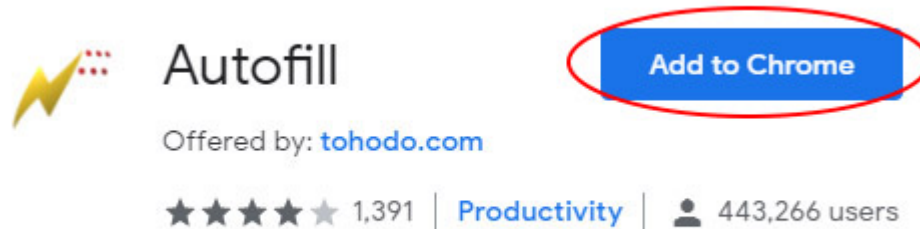


Set up Autofill on Web Forms in Jira

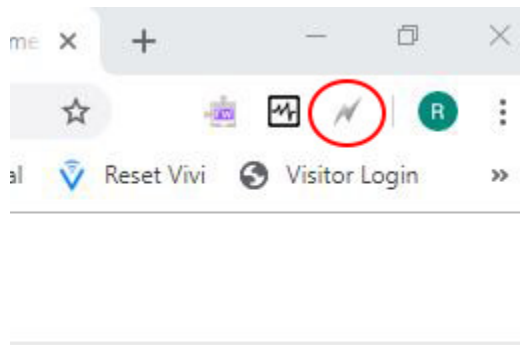
This process sets up Chrome to automatically fill in information when filling up laptop repair forms in the Jira Laptop Care process.

Step-by-step guide

1. The "Autofill" chrome extension is needed to do this and can be downloaded by going to the chrome webstore store and searching for this.
2. On the search results the extension should come up like below.



3. Click on the Add to Chrome button to install the extension. Once installed the extension will appear in the upper right portion of the browser as a thunderbolt icon.



4. Right click on the icon and select Options

5. In the Autofill Options dialogue, click on (1) Import/Export and copy and paste the following URL (<http://xibo-http.bci.local/autofil-toshiba.txt>) on the remote file box (2). Make sure Auto-import settings is ticked and click on Import (3).

To import settings into Autofill, paste the CSV data into the box below and click Import. To export the current settings to a CSV file, click Export, copy the generated data, paste it into a text editor, and save the file with extension .csv.
