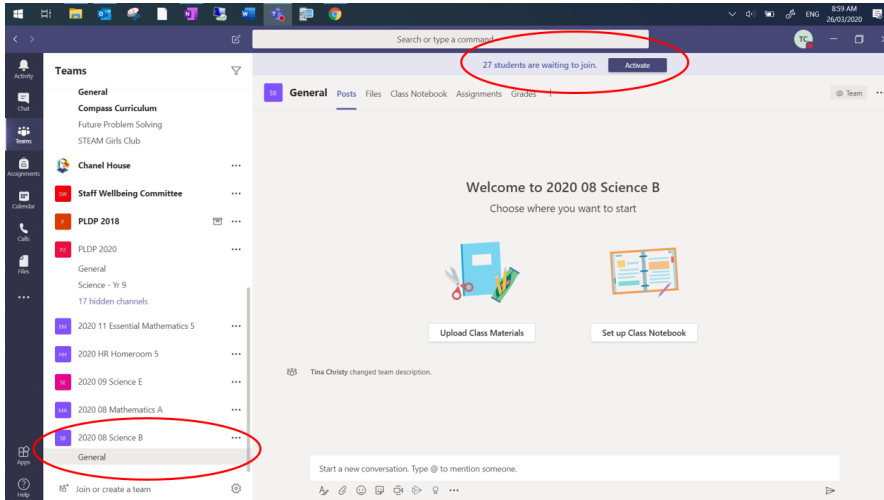


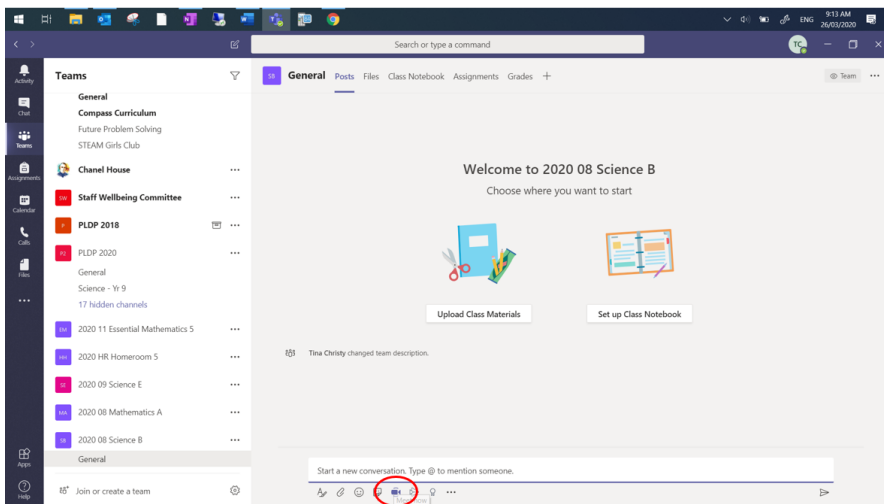
Quick guide to Microsoft Teams - Class Team

Starting Video Calls (as Demonstrated in the Video Above)

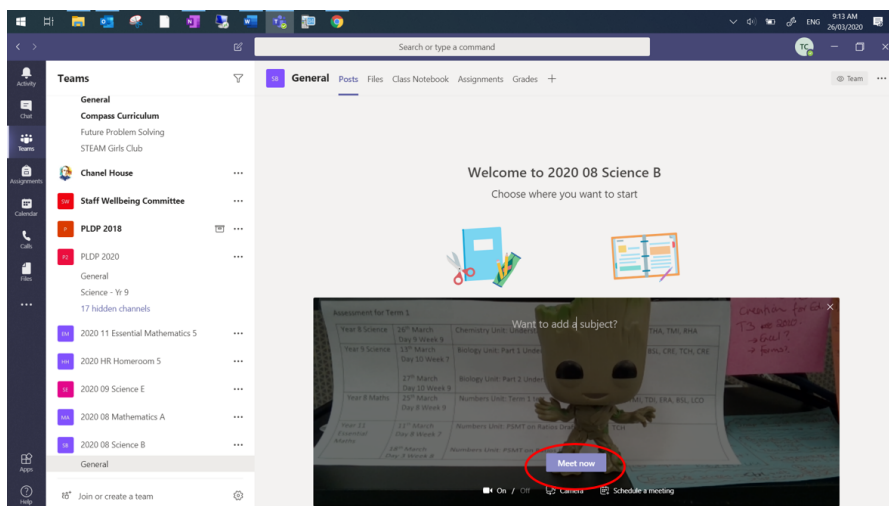
1. Go to Teams and find your class



2. Click on 'Activate' when using for the first time
3. Click 'OK' to activate
4. Click on the video symbol



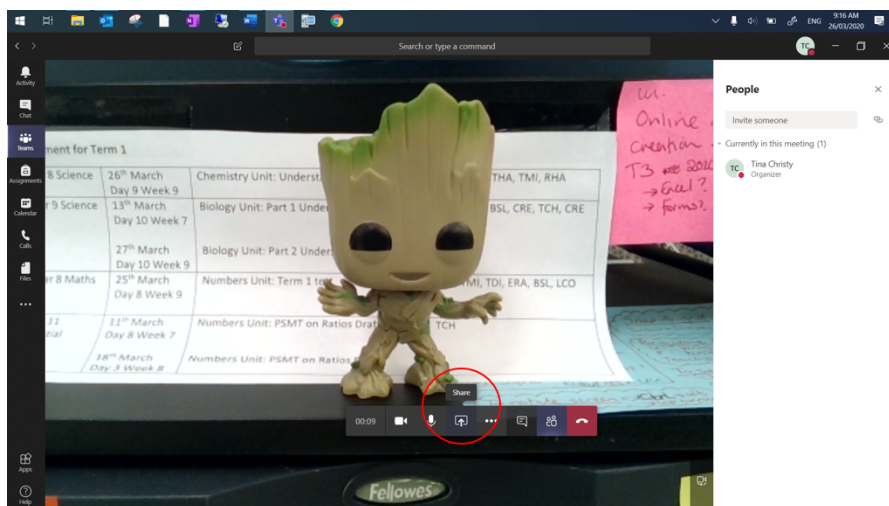
5. Click 'Meet Now'



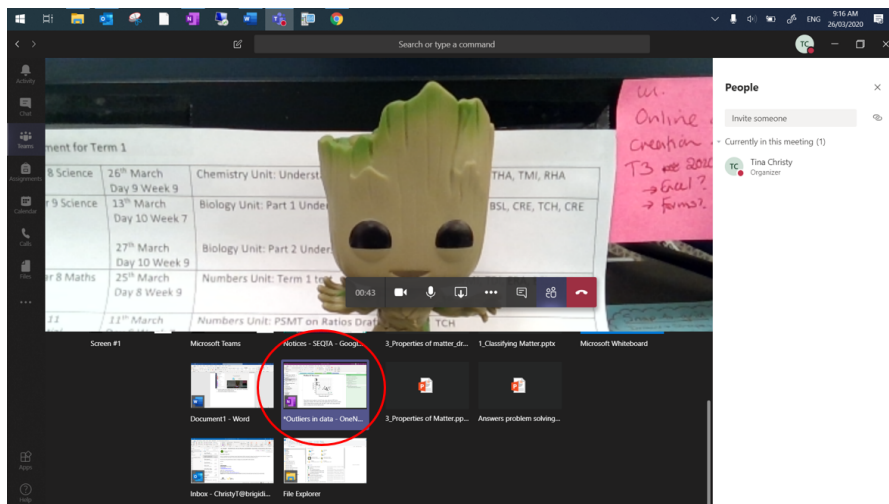
6. Then your students need to open up 'Microsoft Teams' and click on 'Join'. You should be able to see them. Once you do ask them to mute their audio.

Sharing Your Screen (as Demonstrated in the Video Above)

1. To share your screen, click on 'Share'.



2. Then select the screen you want to share. Make sure to turn off your camera before writing in OneNote.

Average math score

Participation (% taking SAT)

Some high school students in the U.S. take a test called the SAT before applying to colleges. The scatter plot to the right shows what percent of each state's college-bound graduates took the SAT in 2009 - 2010, along with that state's average score on the math section.

Points A, B, and C are marked on the scatter plot.
